



Eastern Canada District of Key Club International & Kiwanis International Foundation Matching "SCHOLARSHIP"



Purpose:

The matching scholarship will be awarded annually (providing there are scholarship funds available each year) at the Eastern Canada District Convention to a Canadian Key Club member who have exemplified to the highest degree, the basic principles of Key Club - caring and sharing - in their homes, schools and communities. The recipient will be of high moral character and should have achieved excellence in all of their endeavors. The District Governor and International Trustees are not eligible for this matching scholarship.

Qualifications:

1. The applicant must have been an active member for two years of Key Club in good standing.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior or equivalent from high school.
3. The applicant must be a college, university, technical or vocational school bound student.
4. The grade point average of the applicant must be a "B" average or the equivalent on a 4.0 scale.
5. This is a \$1000.00 (CAD) one-time award from the District Scholarship Fund and Kiwanis International Foundation.
6. Nominations applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2010
7. Financial need will not be a factor in this award.
8. If the scholarship is not used within one year of date of presentation, funds will revert back to the District Scholarship Fund for future use.
9. The District Governor and International Trustees are not eligible for this matching scholarship.

Procedures:

1. List School Organizations and Activities to which you have contributed significantly, stating any offices held during your years in high school.
2. List Religious and Community Activities to which you have contributed significantly during your years in high school.
3. List Honours, Awards or Special Recognition that you have received during your years in high school.
4. A letter of recommendation from each of the following must be included:
 - A Kiwanian (not necessarily a member of the club that sponsors applicant's home club)
 - A school official
 - An individual of your choice

(Note: each letter must state the capacity in which the individual writing the letter of recommendation is fulfilling, ie: Kiwanian, school official, other)

Write a two page typed, double spaced essay on how Key Club has expanded your leadership abilities.

An official high school transcript must be included.

Note: If all items requested are not included, the application will automatically be disqualified. All application materials become the property of the Eastern Canada District Key Club and will not be returned. The District Governor, District Administrator and Assistant District Administrator shall select the recipient.
